The journey

Watch elephants come down to the Chobe River, follow wildlife tracks across Moremi and explore the Okavango by boat and mokoro. This nine-day safari brings together three of Botswana's finest wildlife settings, with short safari flights linking your stays.

Three nights in Moremi and three in the Delta give you time to settle into each place. Finish with two nights beside the Chobe River, where a different view of the wildlife opens up from the water. Midasia Routes will personalise the arrangements for the people you choose to travel with.

Tour highlights

- **Moremi wildlife**
Explore woodland, grassland and floodplain on expertly guided game drives.
- **Quiet waterways**
Discover the Delta by mokoro and motorboat from your island camp.
- **Time in each setting**
Stay three nights in each Delta area, followed by two in Chobe.
- **The Delta from above**
Enjoy the changing patterns of water and islands on your safari flights.
- **Chobe River safari**
Look for elephants, hippos and birdlife from a different perspective.
- **Made for your party**
Choose room layouts, guiding arrangements and a daily rhythm that suit you.

BEST TIME FOR THIS ROUTE

June to September

June to September brings dry-season safari conditions and excellent opportunities to combine wildlife drives with the waterways of the Okavango. June offers cooler days; September is a rewarding choice for wildlife around rivers and waterholes.

DAY 01

A: 12 June 2027 | B: 4 September 2027

Arrive in Maun & fly into Moremi

On arrival in Maun, meet our representative and connect with your light-aircraft flight into the Okavango region. The view changes from open country to channels, islands and floodplains before you reach your camp airstrip. Settle into Camp Moremi and meet the guides who will introduce you to the reserve. With an afternoon arrival, begin with a first game drive, then return for dinner and an evening listening to the sounds of the bush.

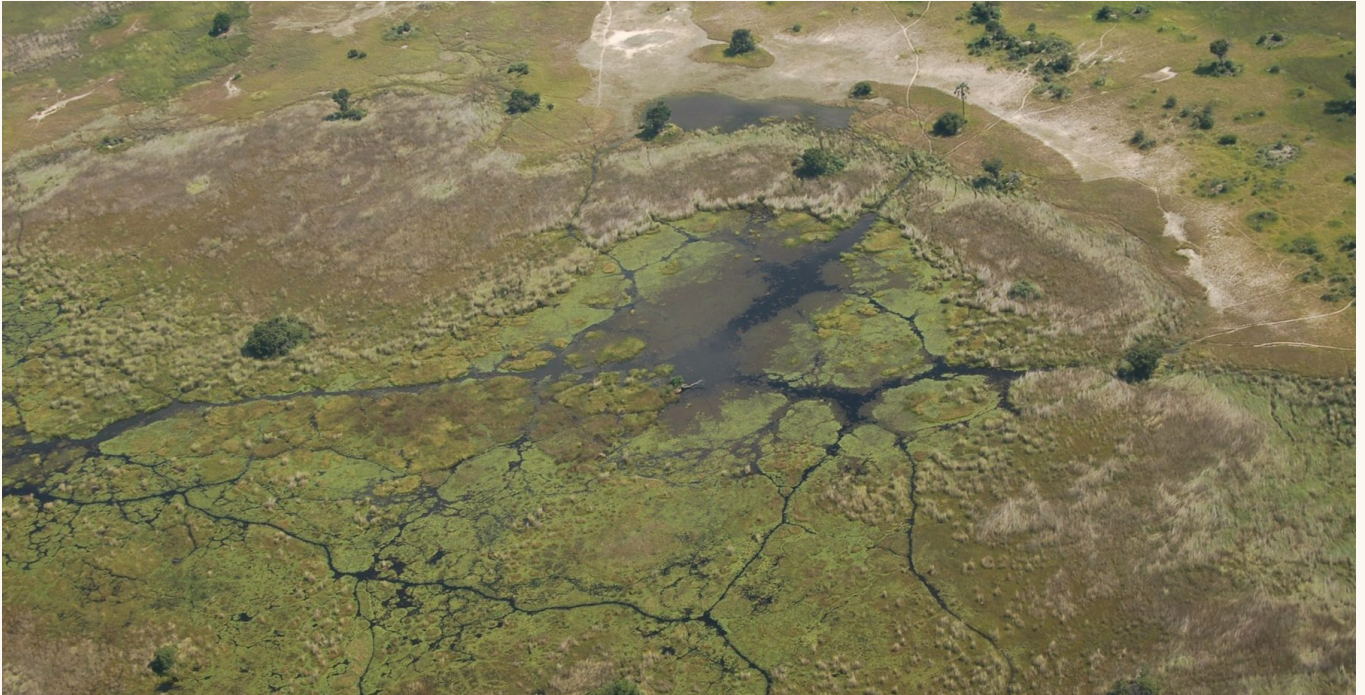
DAY 02

A: 13 June 2027 | B: 5 September 2027

A full day in Moremi Game Reserve

Head out in the cool of the morning, when the reserve begins to stir. Your guide reads tracks and follows recent wildlife activity through Moremi's varied habitats, looking for big cats, elephants, giraffes and antelope. Return to camp for lunch and a relaxed middle of the day. An afternoon drive explores a different area, with time to stop for photographs and watch animal behaviour before returning for dinner.

DAY 03

A: 14 June 2027 | B: 6 September 2027

Moremi at your own pace

Use a second full day to explore beyond your first sightings. You might spend longer with a pride of lions, watch elephants feeding in the woodland or concentrate on the birds along the floodplain. Discuss your interests with the guide over breakfast, then choose the day's focus. Enjoy lunch and time at camp between activities, followed by another afternoon out in the reserve and a final dinner at Camp Moremi.

DAY 04

A: 15 June 2027 | B: 7 September 2027

Fly deeper into the Okavango Delta

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your safari flight to Camp Okavango. Flying over the Delta gives a clear sense of the scale of this inland wetland. Settle into your island camp and enjoy lunch before an introduction to its water-based activities. A guided motorboat excursion follows the channels, with stops to observe birds and waterside wildlife. Return to camp as the light softens for dinner.

DAY 05

A: 16 June 2027 | B: 8 September 2027

Explore by mokoro & motorboat

Start with a guided mokoro outing through the Delta's quieter channels. Moving slowly in the traditional dugout-style canoe lets you notice reeds, water lilies and the smaller details of the wetland. Back at camp, enjoy breakfast or brunch and time to relax. Later, explore farther by motorboat, watching for hippos and birds along the water. Your camp team selects the day's waterways to make the most of local conditions.

Overnight: Camp Okavango

DAY 06

A: 17 June 2027 | B: 9 September 2027

Another day on the Delta's islands

Today gives you time to enjoy the Delta without changing camp. Join another water excursion or an island nature walk arranged by the camp, with the activity matched to your party. Your guide explains how seasonal water shapes the landscape and the lives of its animals. Between outings, relax on your deck or watch the birdlife around camp. End your final Delta evening with dinner and time under the African night sky.

DAY 07

A: 18 June 2027 | B: 10 September 2027

Fly to Kasane & the Chobe River

Leave the Delta after breakfast and fly to Kasane, where a transfer takes you to Chobe Game Lodge. Your next two nights are on the riverfront inside Chobe National Park. Settle into your room and enjoy lunch before a river safari. From the boat, look for elephants on the banks, hippos in the water and fish eagles above the river. Return to the lodge for dinner with river views.

DAY 08

A: 19 June 2027 | B: 11 September 2027

Chobe by land & water

Combine a morning game drive with an afternoon boat safari to enjoy two different views of Chobe. On land, follow the riverfront tracks and woodland routes in search of elephants, buffalo, giraffes and predators. After lunch and a break at the lodge, return to the water for close attention to the river's wildlife and birdlife. There is time to enjoy your favourite sightings before a farewell dinner at the lodge.

DAY 09

A: 20 June 2027 | B: 12 September 2027

Depart from Kasane

Enjoy breakfast overlooking the river and a final quiet morning at the lodge, timed around your onward flight. Your driver transfers you to Kasane Airport for departure. If you would like more time in southern Africa, Midasia Routes can arrange a separate extension to Victoria Falls or another destination to fit your plans.
